



# Paper Roll Pachyderm

### What you'll need to get started:



Paper Roll



**Scissors** 




Markers or Paint & Brush



Tape or Glue

## **STEP 1**

Color in the pieces below and then cut them out.




Body (Wraps around roll)


Trunk

#### STEP 2

Wrap the piece labeled "body" around the paper roll. Overlap the seam in the back and tape or glue to secure.




**STEP 3**Fold ear and trunk pieces back along dotted lines



#### STEP 4


Attach ear and trunk pieces with glue or tape
Optional: Curl your elephant's trunk



#### STEP 5

Attach eyes and draw in pupils. Or draw eyes directly onto your elephant.

Optional: Add googly eyes for a fun effect
