Healthy Habitats activity

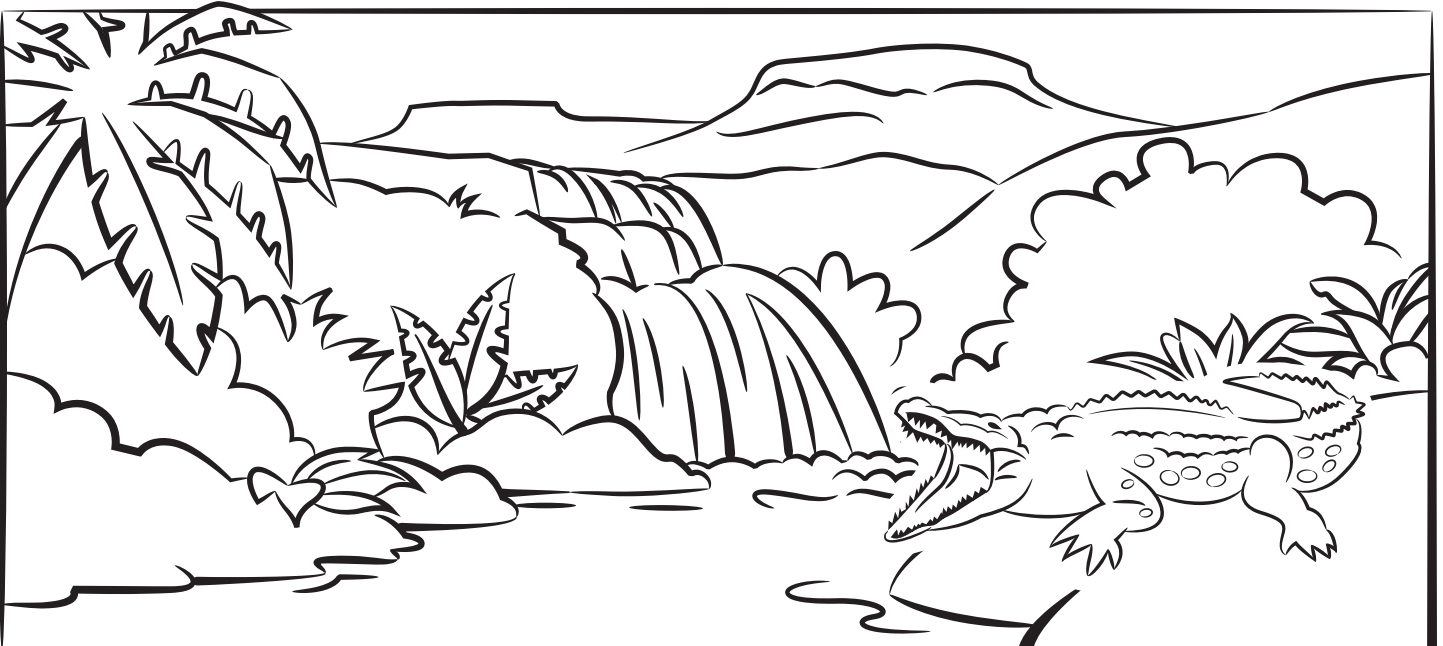
